

Assistant GM Report

As I write, we seem to be in a deep freeze here in Eagles Mere to start the new year. The good news is that possibly this is the year for the toboggan slide. Along with the start of the new year comes our annual dues billing and the 2018 Rules and Regulation booklet. It also brings an updated web portal which will allow members to make payments on their account.

Your next billing statement will contain the 2018 annual dues which includes a modest increase over 2017. Please keep in my mind that the dues are due April 1st. As you may recall, Full Members may now use the fitness center without incurring any additional fees. Social Members may use the facility as well, just let us know if you would prefer an annual, six month or a three month membership and we will bill accordingly. If you are interested please contact the Business Office to obtain an access card and sign a liability waiver. If anyone has any questions concerning your billing please call or email me. My contact information is listed below.

The 2018 Rules and Regulations booklet has been printed and is being mailed to all members. The Membership Committee proposed and the Board of Directors approved two new member classifications.

- The return of the **Provisional Membership**. This type of membership allows a new member to enjoy full member privileges for the current fiscal year by paying the annual dues. Upon the expiration of the current fiscal year, if the membership is continued the initiation fee will be billed. This was available in 2009 and it generated two new members.
- **Existing Social Member Step-Up**: A current Social Member in good standing shall have the one-time opportunity, for a period of one fiscal year, to step up to a Full Golfing membership to afford that member and his/her family the opportunity to evaluate whether he/she wishes to become a permanent Full Golfing Member. The annual dues will be the current social dues plus half of the difference of the full member dues, therefore, for 2018 it would be \$2,380.

If you wish any further information on either of the above please contact the Business Office. This booklet also contains lots of additional information about your membership; it lists all fees, explains all of your Club's policies, lists Club golf tournaments and contains contact information.

We have had many members request the ability to make **payments on their account via our web portal**. We are working with the developers to create this feature and we anticipate that it will be completed by the end of January 2018. We will send an email to the membership when it is available. Members will incur a charge when using this feature but all charges will be detailed to you at the time of payment. Once you log in to your web portal you'll need to select My Statements then follow the prompts. You can access the web portal from our website (www.eaglesmerecc.com). Your log in will be your first name followed by your four digit account number. The default password is 1234567, however, you have the ability to update your password by selecting My Profile. If you experience any issues or wish to be walked through the process please contact the Business Office.

I hope 2018 is prosperous to everyone and you're able to enjoy time with family and friends.
